HERE ARE SOME THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT BUILDINGWORKS BEFORE YOU APPLY:

BuildingWorks is a pre-apprenticeship training that prepares individuals for the Carpenters Union Apprenticeship. Successful candidates for BuildingWorks should have a strong career interest in <u>union carpentry</u>. They should be able to demonstrate, through personal experience, the ability to commit to projects, and the likelihood of completing the 4-year carpenter apprenticeship leading to a long and successful career as a union carpenter. No previous experience with carpentry or construction is necessary, but we hope that candidates share with us any previous experience through work, school, training, or volunteering.

- Applicants should have a strong interest in Carpentry and commit to completing the
 4-year apprenticeship leading to a career as a Union Carpenter.
- Applicants must be willing and able to work on job sites <u>anywhere in New York City</u> <u>and vicinity</u>.
- Applicants must pass a drug screen.
- Training starts January 9 and ends February 3, 2022.
- Full-Day Sessions are held Mon. to Fri. 7:00 am 4:00 pm. (start/end times may vary)
- Sessions will be held in person at the Carpenters Training Center in lower Manhattan. There is a <u>strict attendance policy</u>. No excused absences or lateness for any reason.

Please follow these steps to apply:

Find and scan your Diploma or GED	A scan of your original <u>High School Diploma or GED or TASC certificate</u> must be submitted with your application. Diploma must be from an accredited high school (online programs are not accepted). In place of a diploma, we will accept an official High School transcript in original form with a signature, raised seal and your graduation date. We do NOT accept letters from a High School official. Diplomas in a foreign language must be accompanied by a translation.
Email completed Application	Print and complete the 4-page application form. Scan completed application with your High School diploma or GED certificate and EMAIL to: <u>buildingworks@nycdcctc.org</u> All applications must be <u>emailed</u> by 12 noon January 3, 2023. We are not able to accept applications received by mail or delivered in person.
3 Attend webinar and complete online test	By 4pm on January 3, you will receive an email with log-in information for a mandatory applicant webinar to be held January 4. Check your email, spam and junk folders. All applicants MUST log-in on time and participate in this online session. Following the session, you will receive a link to an online test. You must attend the webinar and complete the online test for your application to remain in consideration.
4 Interview	Applicants who remain in consideration after the test will be contacted by email with an interview appointment. Interviews will be held virtually. You must show originals of the required documents. (See page 2 of application for required documents).
